Orange County Public Schools, The School District of Osceola County, and Valencia College are partners in the Career Pathways program, which offers students the opportunity to focus on technical high school programs that will help train them for high-skill, high wage occupations. Sixteen national career clusters have been designated and career pathways have been developed around these clusters. Each career pathway shows the transition from the high school program to postsecondary education, including the technical centers, Valencia, and baccalaureate programs. While high school students are preparing for careers and postsecondary education, they can begin to earn Valencia college credits by participating in joint assessments developed for many of the programs of study. 2011-2012 Outcomes

Executive Summary

The Career Pathways Outcomes Report reflects a continued strong partnership between Orange County Public Schools, The School District of Osceola County and Valencia College. While enrolled in Career Pathways programs, students are engaging in contextual learning activities and have the opportunity to participate in integrated curriculum projects. As evidenced by the detailed data contained in this booklet, Career Pathways is a viable program that provides career pathways for students and the incentive to continue their education in a postsecondary program.

Career Clusters and Pathways

Career Pathways are developed for all programs of study available in the consortium and are available on the consortium website <http://www.valenciacollege.edu/careerpathways>.

Opportunities are available for high school students and technical center adults to articulate to the college. Technical center articulation and other transfer articulation are available at <http://valenciacollege.edu/asdegrees/transferagreements.cfm>.

Joint Assessments

- 4,447 Career Pathways students took 5,933 joint assessments and passed 4,260 assessments.
- The current dollar value of Valencia College credits available to all students who passed an assessment this year is \$847,260.18 (8,553 credit hours overall x \$99.06 per credit hour).

College Credits through Industry Certification

- 494 Career Pathways students passed Microsoft Office Specialist industry certification. Each MOS certification is worth 9 college credits, which equals 4,446 Valencia credit hours potentially worth \$440,420.76 at this year's \$99.06 per credit hour rate.
- Additionally, 10 students passed the AutoDesk Certified Associate - AutoCAD industry certification this year. Each ADESK certification is worth 3 credits, which equals 30 Valencia credit hours potentially worth \$2,971.80 at this year's \$99.06 per credit hour rate.

Postsecondary Transition – Valencia College, Fall 2012

- 9,880 Career Pathways high school graduates were enrolled at Valencia during the Fall 2012 semester, which includes high school graduates from 1995 through 2012:
 - Of these, 15 (0.15%) are seeking a Bachelor's degree, 5,735 (58%) are seeking an AA degree, 595 (6%) are seeking an AA Pre-major degree, 3,238 (33%) are seeking an AS or AAS degree, 88 (.89%) are seeking Technical Certificates, 11 post-Associate certificates (.11%), and 198 (2%) undecided. As of Fall 2012, another 1,469 were pending admission to limited access programs. Details page 14 will provide a breakdown of the degrees and technical certificates. A cohort enrollment chart at the beginning of the green section provides a historical analysis of new students entering the college each term.
 - 2,264 of these students graduated from their high schools in 2012. Of these, 1,396 (62%) are seeking an AA degree, 178 (8%) an AA Pre-major degree, 664 (29%) an AS or AAS degree, 10 (0.4%) Technical Certificates, and 16 (.7%) are undeclared.
 - 1,868 (83%) of these are from Orange County schools, and 396 (17%) are from Osceola County schools.
 - Percentage who took the CPT and required mandated remediation: Reading 55%, Writing 38%, Math 56%.

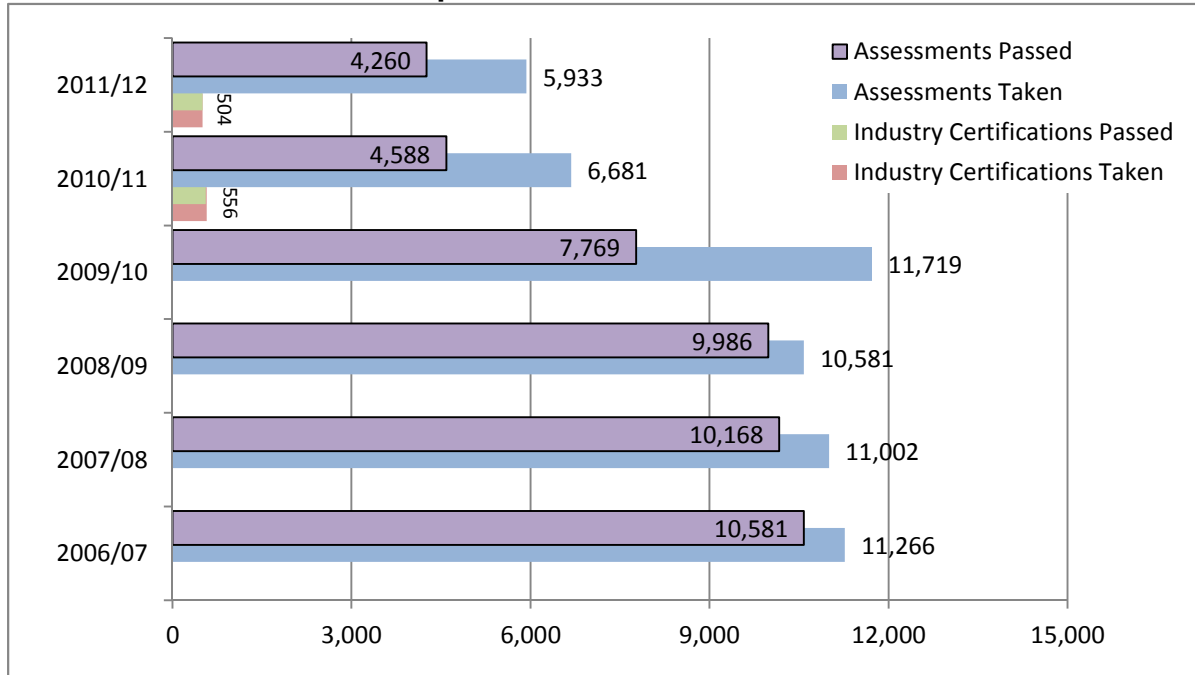
- 48,656 high school students have become eligible to receive Valencia college credits by passing assessments in the Career Pathways program (includes students from 1995 to 2012):
 - Students can claim the credits up to 24 months after high school graduation.
 - 17,908 students (37% of the 48,656 eligible) have enrolled at Valencia within 24 months of their high school graduation and were awarded 79,391 credit hours for a combined dollar value of **\$5,382,756.73**.
- Valencia retention rates for Career Pathways students after one year: 62% of the Career Pathways students who attended in Fall, 2011 were also enrolled Fall, 2012.

Valencia Graduate Data

- 12,011 Career Pathways students received 12,986 degrees and certificates from Valencia (1995-2012):
 - 9,368 (72%) students graduated with AA degrees
 - 1,283 (10%) students graduated with AA Pre-Major degrees
 - 1,803 (14%) students graduated with AS or AAS degrees
 - 181 (1%) students graduated with Technical Certificates
 - 351 (3%) students graduated with Vocational Credit Certificates

Potential Dollar Value of Assessments

The potential tuition value saved by students in the 2011-2012 school year through assessments was **\$847,260** which represents 8,553 college credits at \$99.06 per credit hour.



Over the last six years, the average number of passing attempts for accelerated credit was **8,072** per year.

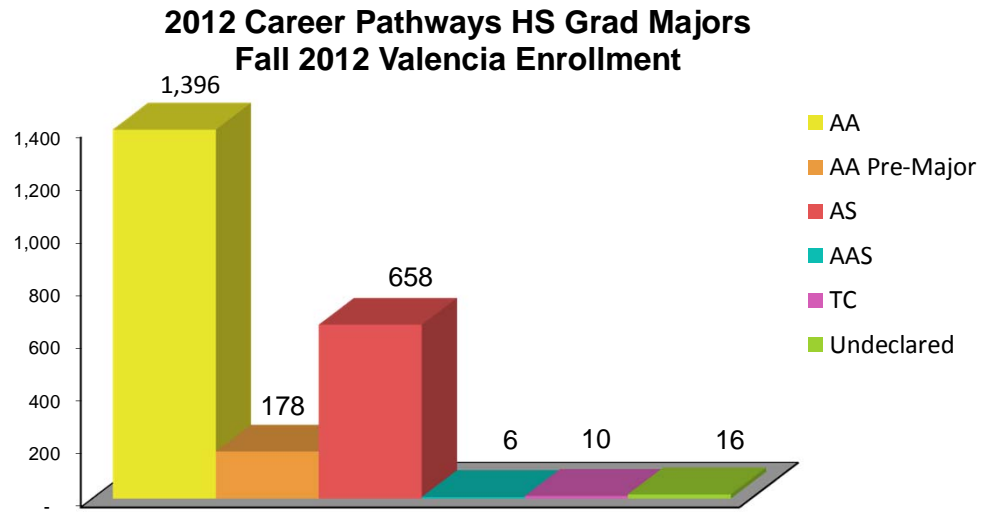

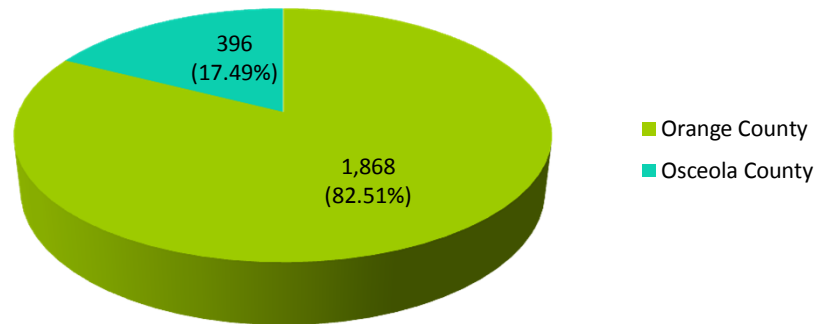

2012 Career Pathways Grads at Valencia by County

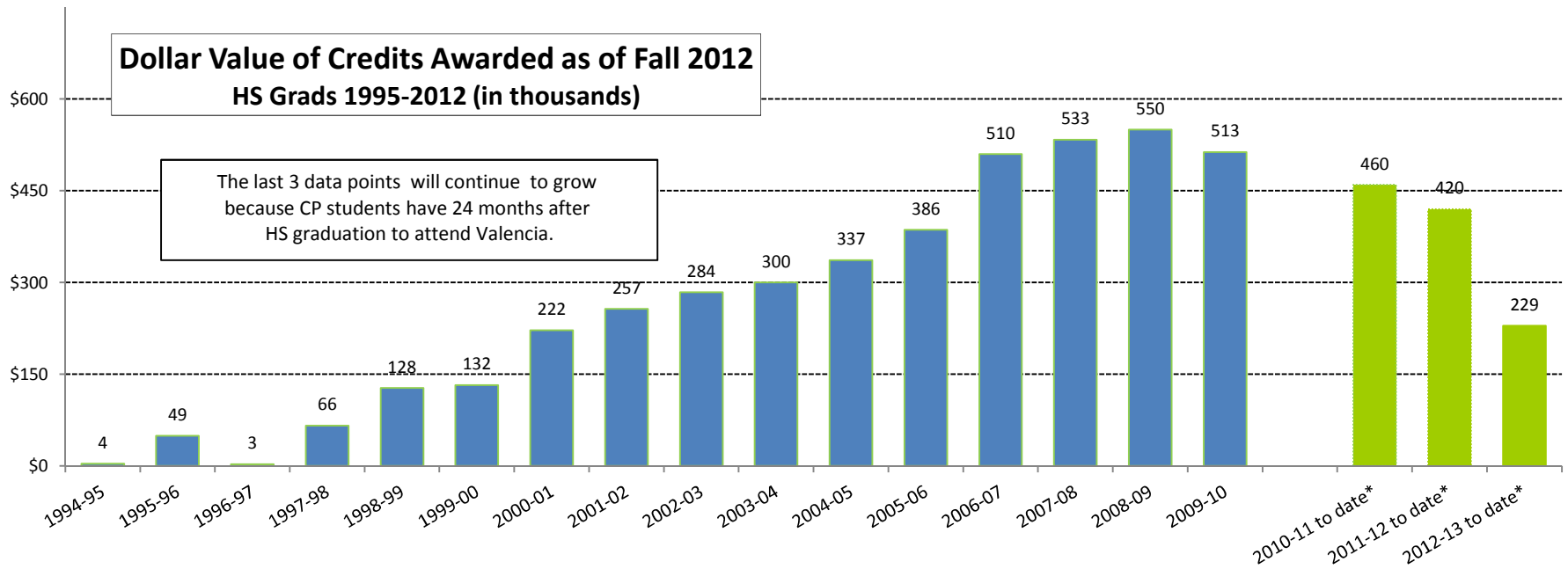
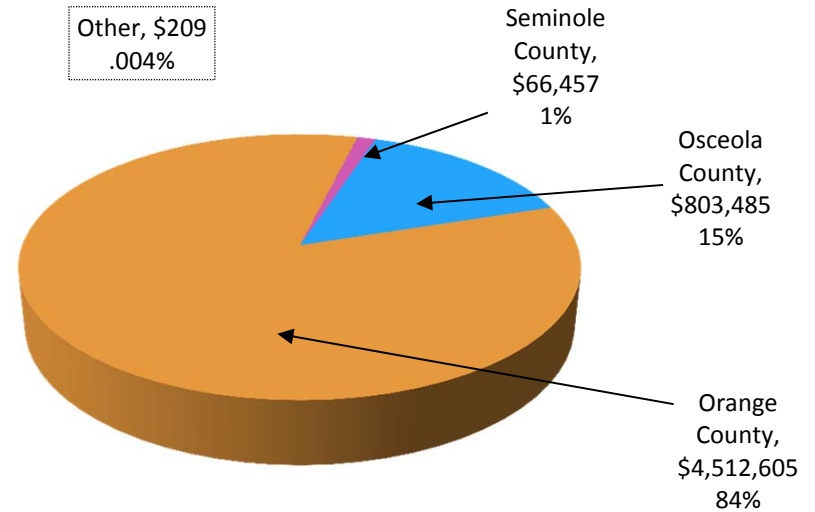


Tuition Saved by Career Pathways Students at Valencia

Since 1995, **\$5,382,756.73** has been saved in tuition by **17,908** Career Pathways students who have attended Valencia.

The student count 17,908 represents **36.8%** of the 48,656 eligible high school students who have passed a Career Pathways assessment.

Students have 24 months from high school graduation to attend Valencia and receive Career Pathways credits.



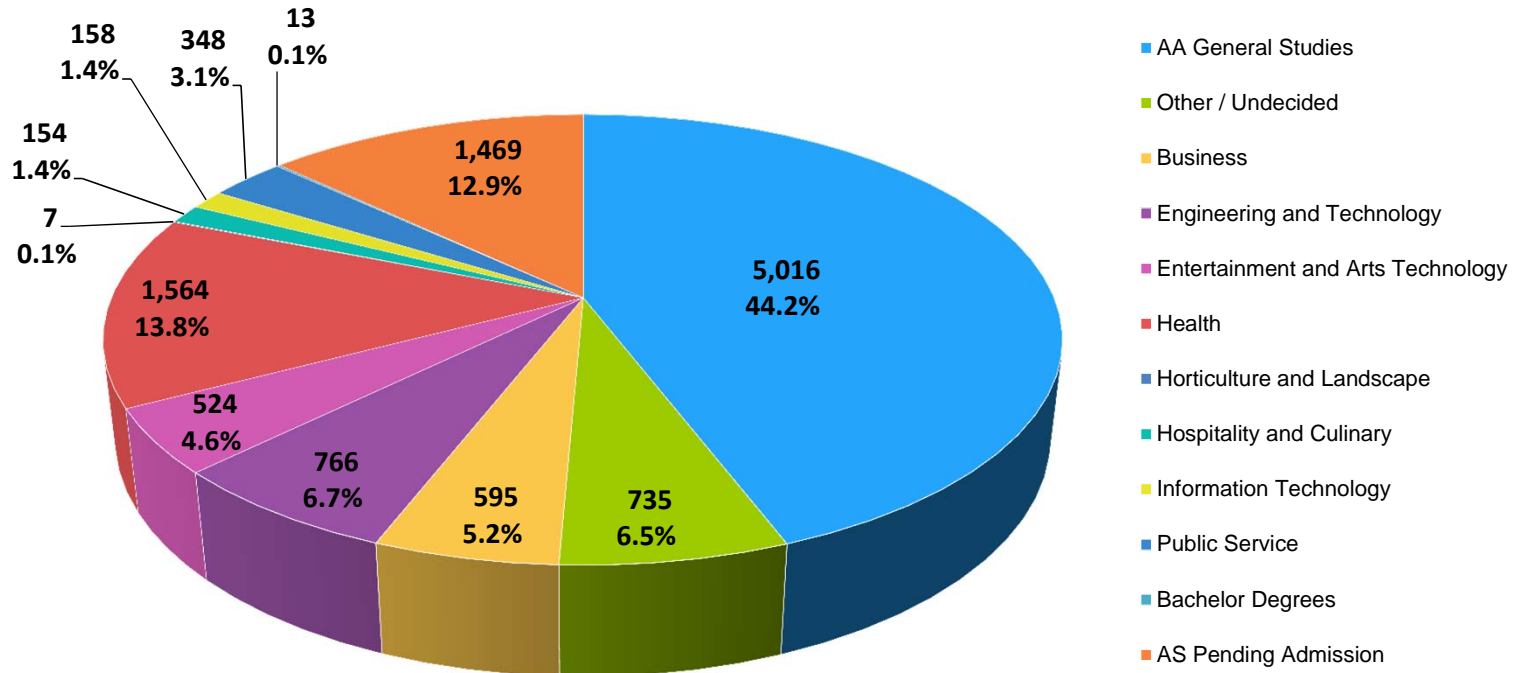

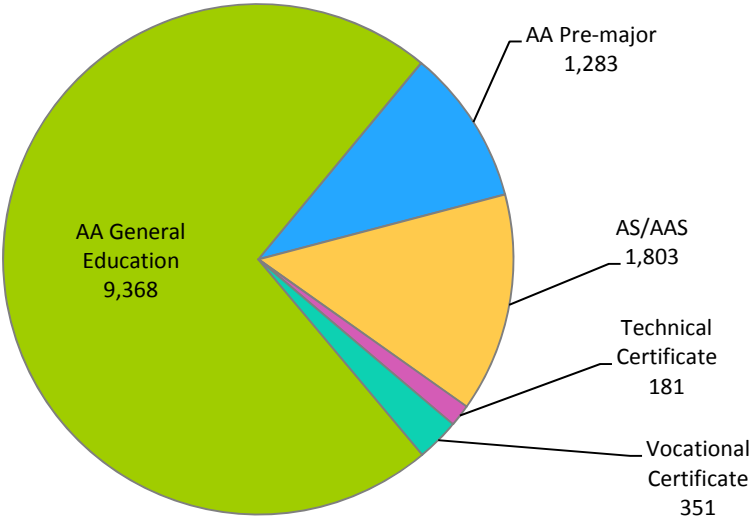
