


Spring 2024 Enrollment Report

Longitudinal FTE Comparison

Our Spring 2024 full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollment represents the largest Spring semester <u>ever</u> at Valencia College. FTE enrollment grew 8% from Spring 2023 to Spring 2024, increasing to 13,371. The previous high was 13,243 FTE in Spring 2020.



Enrollment by Student Type

This record-setting enrollment reflects an increase in new students as well as returning students. In Fall 2023, Valencia College welcomed nearly 8,300 first-time-in-college students, the largest number of new students in any semester ever at the College. In addition, Valencia students achieved their highest fall-to-fall retention (a measure of success and persistence), resulting in an increased percentage of second-year students returning in Spring 2024 to continue their studies. As these large cohorts of students continue their studies, we will continue to see positive impacts to enrollment as returning students account for 73% of overall enrollment in any given term.

Full-Time/Part-Time Status

There is a double-digit percentage increase in full-time (12 or more credit hours) enrolled students for spring 2024. This increase in enrollment intensity explains why FTE growth (8%) is higher than headcount growth. Full time enrollment by returner students increased 13.8% for Spring 2024.

Enrollment by Student Modality

There were substantial increases in enrollment in students enrolling in at least one face-to-face (F2F) course. For Spring 2024, 50.4% of students are enrolled in at least one face-to-face class.

Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity

Hispanic students represent over 47% of Spring 2024 enrollment. Compared to Spring 2023, there has been an 11% enrollment increase by Hispanic students and a 6.7% enrollment increase by African American students, reflecting the changing demographics of Valencia's service district.
