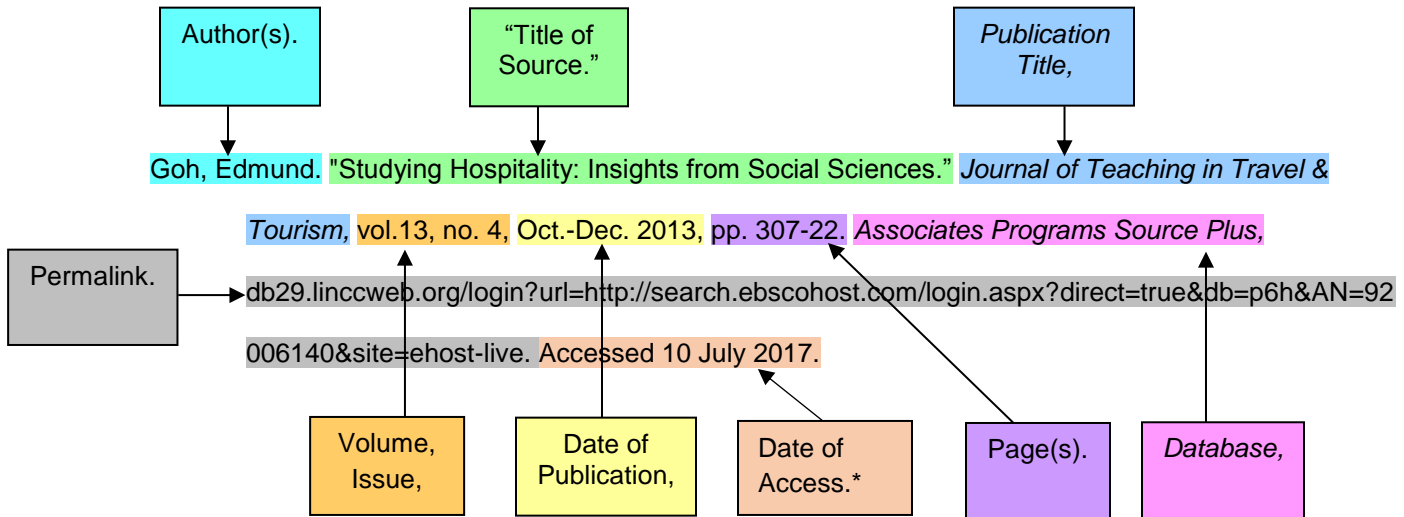

### Example: Journal Article – No Digital Object Identifier (DOI)

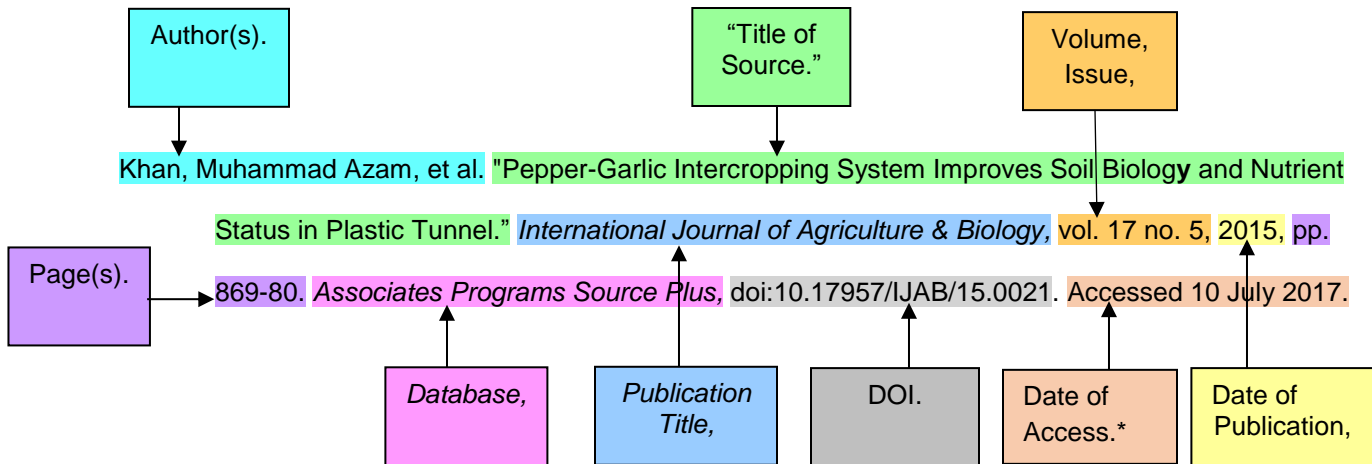


In-text citation: Edmund explains that "text of quotation" (308).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Edmund 308).

**Example: Journal Article - Three or more Authors – With Digital Object Identifier (DOI)**

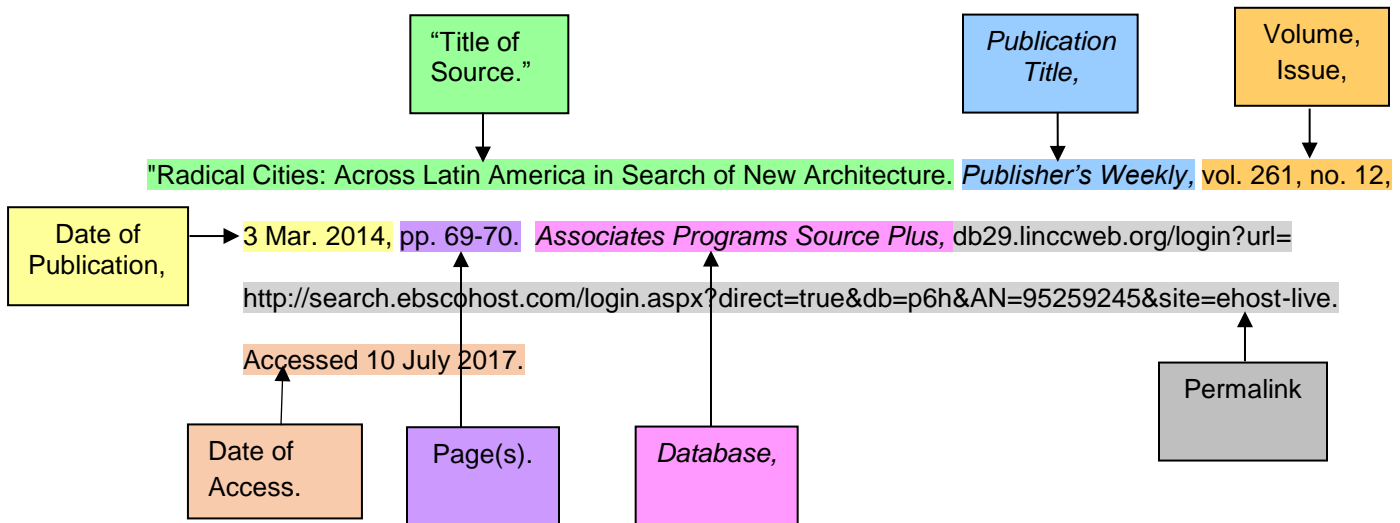


**In-text citation:** According to Khan et al., "text of quotation" (7).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Khan et al. 7).

**Example: Periodical Article – No Author**



In-text citation: "Text of quotation" ("Radical Cities" 69).
