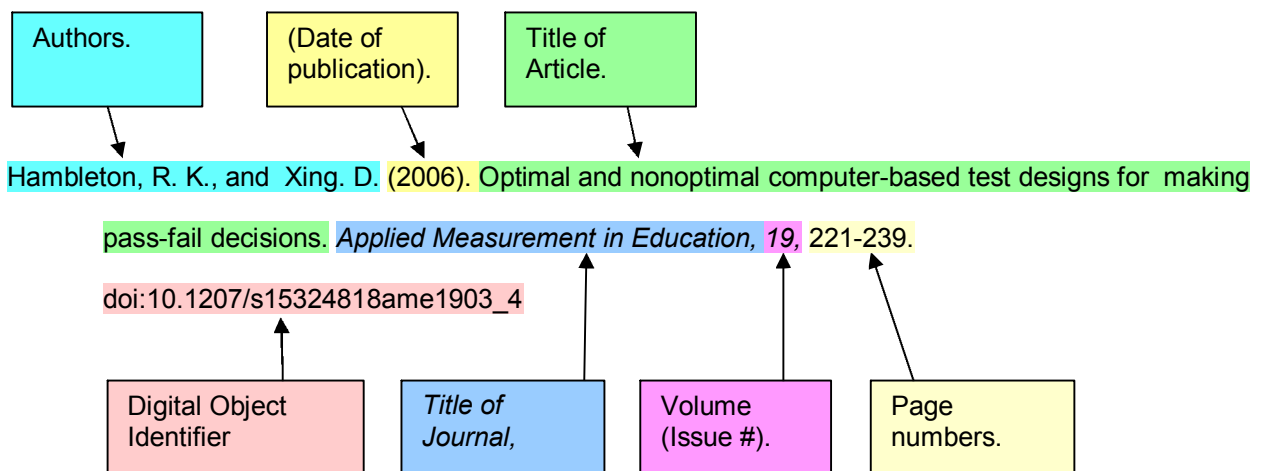

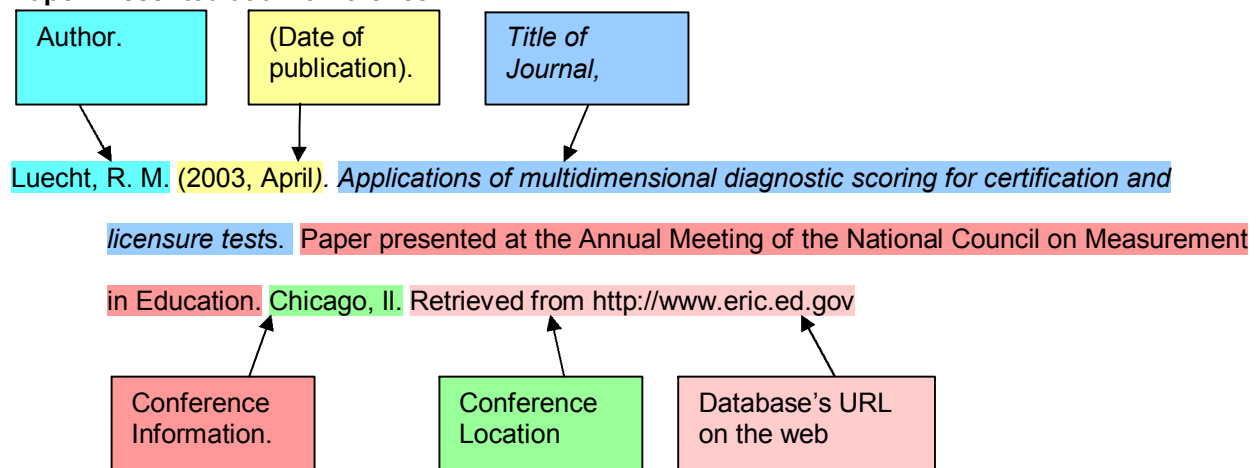

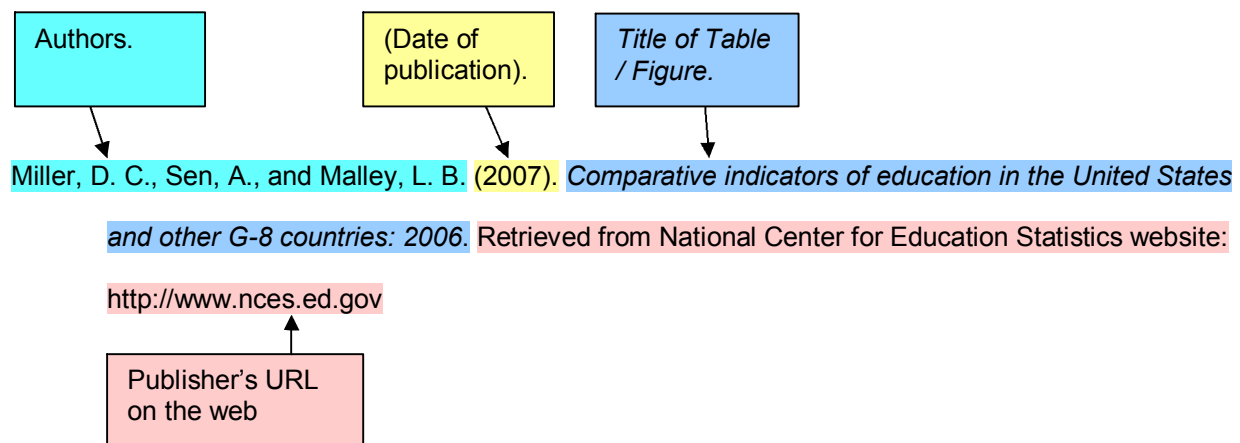

- In-text citation for a paraphrase, first time: (Miller, Sen, & Malley, 2007); thereafter use (Miller et al, 2007)
