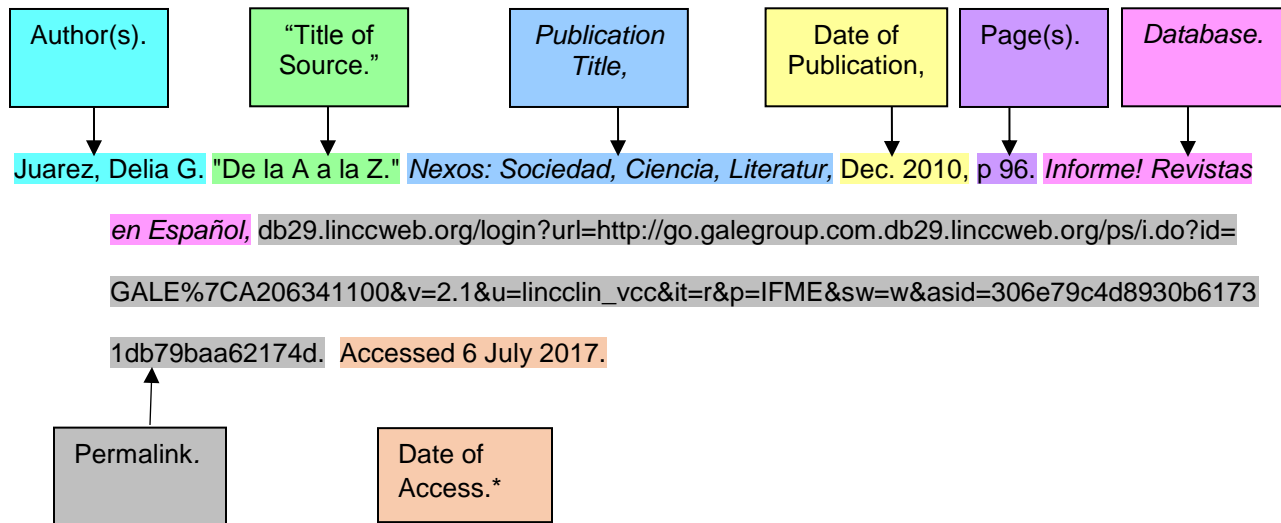

Example: Periodical Article



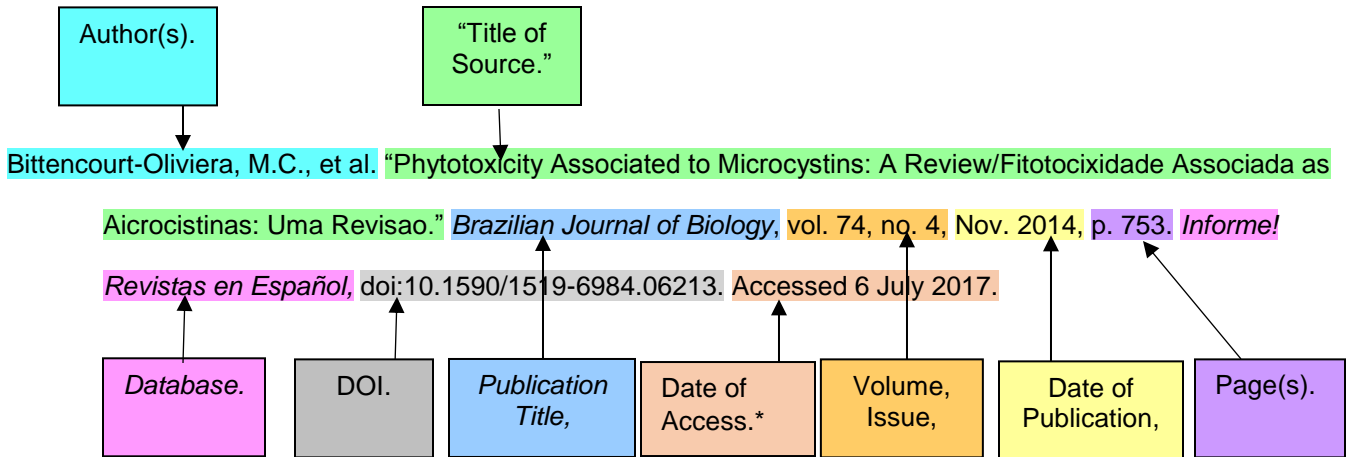
First citation: Delia G. Juarez explains "text of quotation" (96).

Subsequent citations: Juarez states "text of quotation" (96).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Juarez 96).

Example: Journal Article – With Digital Object Identifier (DOI)



First citation: M.C. Bittencourt-Oliviera and others claim "text of quotation" (753).

Subsequent citations: Bittencourt-Oliviera et al. emphasize "text of quotation" (753).

OR

"Text of quotation" (Bittencourt-Oliviera et al. 753).

* The date of access is optional; however, it is commonly used. When using optional elements, refer to your assignment or course guidelines or preferences expressed by your professor.
