The assessment results reinforced the need to develop and support a continuous training program for all staff with responsibilities for the admission and advisement for international students. The training program must reflect current and updated training in compliance with federal regulations governing the enrollment of international students. The frequency of the training must be a major consideration. The quarterly time frame must be adjusted based on involvement of staff in professional development activities in-house as well as those occurring on a state, regional and national level.
