




Student Experience Statement


Valencia College will provide a transformational education exemplified by an engaging and empowering student experience, characterized by:

What Will Be Different for Students?


- Students will see amount of financial aid available to them in Spring.

- Staff will spend significantly less time in manual processing and be able to rely more heavily on native workflows.
- The College will be able to install and utilize standard software updates without having to update custom scripts.

Strategic Investment: Earlier Fall Registration

What Will Be Different for Students?


- Continuing Valencia students will be able to register for Summer and Fall classes before end of Spring term.
- First-time-in-college students will be able to register at Valencia before graduating from high school.

What Will Be Different for Employees?

- Advisors will have opportunity to work with returning students in Spring to plan for Summer and Fall.
- Student Affairs employees will experience less dramatic "peaks."

Requests of District Board of Trustees:

- Approval of 2023-24 Tuition (December 2022)
- Approval of 2023-24 Fees (March 2023)



Strategic Investment: New Portal

What Will Be Different for Students?

- Students will have access to a mobile-friendly portal to register for classes, review financial aid available, and pay balance due.
- Students will be able see a map of progress toward their degree and easily register for next courses in recommended sequence.

What Will Be Different for Employees?

- Employees will receive fewer requests for "transactional" information, allowing for greater opportunities for proactive outreach to students.
- The app will allow for more streamlined communication with students.
