


Fall 2024 Enrollment Report

Headcount & FTE

At present, unduplicated headcount for fall 2024 is 49,204, representing our highest fall enrollment in the history of the college. The total number of students enrolled at Valencia increased 6% from Fall 2023 to Fall 2024, and full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment (a measure of credit hours) increased 5.9% from last fall.



Enrollment by Student Type

We continue to see strong enrollment across the primary student types of First-Time-in-College (FTIC) and Returner students. Returner student enrollment increased 7.7%, which accounts for nearly 60% of our overall enrollment each term. FTIC enrollment increased 5.2%. For Fall 2024, we saw our highest ever number of admission applications as well as our highest ever applicant yield percentage.


Enrollment by Modality

While online courses remain popular, there were substantial increases in enrollment in mixed mode and onsite classes. 55% of students have at least one class that meets on campus.

Enrollment by Ethnicity

For Fall 2024, 49.2% of students enrolled at Valencia are Hispanic. For comparison, Hispanic students comprised approximately 47% of enrollment for Fall 2023. Fall 2024 enrollment shows a 12.2% increase of Hispanic students from Osceola County and a 10.8% increase from Orange County. There is also a 6.9% increase in enrollment of Black and African American students.



Enrollment by Pell Eligibility

For Fall 2024, nearly 65% of students enrolled at Valencia were offered Pell. This is a 12.6% increase from Fall 2023. This is notable simply because of the increase, but especially because of the issues surrounding the US Department of Education rollout of the FAFSA Simplification Act.
