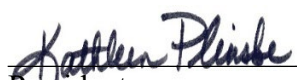
RE: AWARD OF ELLUCIAN ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING (ERP) SYSTEM
RENEWAL AND MODERNIZATION AGREEMENT

Valencia College has utilized Ellucian's Banner enterprise resource planning (ERP) system for over 20 years to support core institutional operations, including student administration, financial aid, finance, human resources, and related business functions. The College is seeking approval to enter into a new ten-year agreement with Ellucian that continues this long-standing relationship while modernizing the College's existing ERP environment. Under the agreement, the College will transition from its existing Banner and related software to Ellucian's cloud-based Advanced Administration platform, including Ellucian Student Signature and HCM and Finance, while continuing certain complementary Ellucian products and services. The agreement will run from January 1, 2027 through December 31, 2036.

In accordance with Rule 6A-14.0734(2)(g), F.A.C., the College utilized the information technology procurement exception to the requirement to solicit competitive offers and negotiated favorable pricing directly with Ellucian. The proposed agreement is for a ten-year term at a total combined cost of \$28,580,500, including credits totaling \$726,233 during the first three years of the agreement. This not-to-exceed funding amount includes items within the Carryforward Spending Plan for the 2025-2026 Fund Balance.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The President recommends that the District Board of Trustees of Valencia College authorize the College to renew and modernize its Ellucian enterprise resource planning (ERP) system through a ten-year agreement with Ellucian at a total cost of \$28,580,500, as presented.
