**1213-191 PSY 2861 Positive Psychology, CCA.....Linda Freeman**

**Purpose:** Positive Psychology is the newest branch to be added to the discipline of psychology. Current research notes that Positive Psychology is a "balanced accompaniment" to traditional psychology. In the past, traditional psychology has studied human weakness. Positive Psychology suggests there is more to human functioning and has focused its research efforts on exploring human strengths and how individuals flourish and thrive both individually and in a community; **Catalog Course Description:** This course is designed to introduce a strength-based psychology that scientifically studies positive human functioning, specifically, the strengths and virtues that enable individuals and communities to thrive. Emphasis will be placed on studying and applying topics such as; happiness, gratitude, flow, optimism and hope, wisdom and courage, positive affect, resilience, coping, friendship, and positive development. **Prerequisites:** None; **Co-requisites:** None; **Credit/Class (Lecture)/Lab Hours:** 3/3/0; **Effective Date:** Fall 2013 (201410).

*There was some discussion about use of the words "positive affect" in the last sentence of the catalog course description. That phrase was changed to "positive effect" since all the other topics that are listed are nouns.*
