ONE VALENCIA CAMPAIGN

The foundation has kicked off its “One Valencia” gift campaign. The goal is to raise \$15 million over five years, capturing renewed interest and enthusiasm for the college in the wake of the recognition by the Aspen Institute and to maximize on the college’s extensive ROI marketing campaign.

A portion of the funds will be used to:

- Fully match the Johnson Family Foundation Challenge grant for Valencia student scholarships, both at Valencia and UCF.
- Match a portion of the Aspen Prize funds to create a \$1 million Aspen Endowment for Excellence to be used for innovation to improve student learning outcomes at scale.
- Fully match the Seneff family gift to grow the Seneff Honors College endowment to \$2 million.
