The Counselor for Real Estate Developers (CRE) Foundation provides funding to projects that have social and community significance. In collaboration with the Creative Village Development, LLC, Valencia will apply for CRE funding to support lifelong learning within the community.</p> <p>Funding will support the creation of a community art wall to be located in Creative Village featuring an educational phrase such as “Education in my community means” with plenty of open spaces for responses. The art wall serves three primary purposes “as information gathering to inform Creative Villages educational partners; raising community awareness about Creative Village and; begins to establish place art wall design and development, maintenance, community engagement, continuous research, and designer costs.</p> <p>The broad goal of this project is to increase engagement of Parramore neighborhood residents through low-tech, creative measures.</p> <p>The significant impact of this project is to support Valencia’s participation in the Creative Village initiative along with learning more about the local community and effective ways that the college might impact their educational pursuits.</p> <p>This proposal is innovative because it is a new, easily accessible for local residents, and is a creative way for residents to engage in the initiative that will be developed in their community.</p>	\$20,000.00	\$0.00	Pending
