Celebrating the foundation's endowed faculty chairs

Earlier this month, foundation board members met with the 35 endowed faculty chairs to recognize their creativity and academic scholarship in an evening celebration. Three professors showcased their projects to serve students.

Foundation disbursements and contributions increase

As of Feb. 28, funds distributed \$2.2 million dollars this fiscal year, as compared with \$1.75 last fiscal year. The amount of scholarships has 54 percent, allowing the foundation to expanding funding to deserving students. Foundation donations climbed from \$1.2 million to \$1.35 million, year over year, while the endowment increased from \$61 million to \$66 million from March 2014 to December 2014. Non-endowed funds grew from \$494,000 to \$575,00, while endowed gifts increased from \$377,000 to \$444,000.
