

Items designed to correlate to the Gen Ed Checklist scores of the other disciplines so we have outcomes-level results across disciplines. The assessment is conducted in an Excel sheet and then administered in Qualtrics, so they do not use a copy in Word.

1. The speaker states a clear thesis.
2. The speaker's thesis and message are relevant to the audience.
3. The speaker reasons logically, providing evidence that supports the thesis.
4. The speaker provides oral references to the credible sources (e.g., author/authority, title, date, website, data base, journal, book, etc.) exposing bias of the source as necessary.
5. The speaker's assumptions (personal bias) are justifiable given the situation and evidence the speaker presents.
