Who is a Pending Nursing student?



A student's primary or secondary major is declared as "*Pending Nursing*" when applying to Valencia College.

All Nursing programs are *limited access;* this means you will not be considered a Nursing student until after you apply and are accepted into the program. If accepted, your major will be changed to "**Nursing**."

Degrees Offered at Valencia College



Types of Nursing Education & Degrees

Associate in Arts (A.A.): Offered at state and community colleges. General two-year degree designed for students who want to transfer to a University Traditional BSN program.

Associate of Science in Nursing (A.S.N.): Offered at state and community colleges. Designed for students who want to enter the workforce immediately and may also want to complete a BSN.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing, RN to BSN: Offered at state colleges and universities. This is a completion program that provides an opportunity for nurses to further their education and increase their potential for career advancement.

ASN and BSN are degrees that a student earns.

Nursing, Accelerated Track

This option is designed for those who have a current, state of Florida, LPN (Licensed Practical Nurse), Paramedic, CVTs (Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Technologist) or RRTs (Registered Respiratory Therapist) who want to earn an A.S. degree in Nursing.

Program Locations: West and Osceola Campus (First semester on the Osceola campus)

Admission Selection: A point system is used in the selection of qualified applicants. Student selection is competitive and based on the total number of points earned. Students must reapply to be considered for a future semester.

All applicants must provide ONE of the following:

- **A)** Documentation of completion of an accredited LPN, Paramedic, RRT or CVT program (completion of program must be prior to application deadline and submission of official transcript is required).
 - **B)** If you hold an LPN license, but did not graduate from an LPN Program, contact the School of Nursing to determine eligibility.

Valencia/UCF Concurrent Track

This track provides a unique dual enrollment opportunity, allowing students to seek the Associate of Science in Nursing (A.S.N.) from Valencia and the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) from the University of Central Florida simultaneously. The Traditional ASN program requirements apply to the Valencia/UCF Concurrent program, as students accepted into Valencia/UCF Concurrent are accepted to the Traditional Nursing program.

Program Locations: Students indicate VC preference in the application: Day West Campus, Day Osceola Campus, or Evening/Weekend West Campus (*preference is not guaranteed*)

Admission Selection: A point system is used (by UCF) in the selection of qualified applicants. Student selection is competitive and based on the total number of points earned. There is no rolling admission for this option; students must reapply to be considered for a future semester. Students must meet the admission requirements for both Valencia and UCF.
