MAXIMUM AWARD OF CREDIT

This agreement makes it possible for a student to receive up to (12) semester hours of college credit for the Fire Investigator I Certification towards the Fire Science Technology A.S. degree and/or one of the fire related technical certificate programs at Valencia College which is in accordance with commonly accepted good practice in higher education.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Valencia's faculty and staff who have responsibility for the supervision and coordination of the Fire Science Technology program have assessed the adequacy of the documentation and determined that the learning outcomes, performance standards, and assessment procedures of the examination meet the college standards for college credit course work and that the learning outcomes are consistent with the course work in the A.S. degree being articulated.

AWARD OF CREDIT PROCESS

The transferring student requesting credit must furnish a **valid** and **current** copy of the Fire Investigator I certificate of competency from the State of Florida Bureau of Fire Standards and Training. To have the courses reported on the official Valencia College transcript, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Meet regular College entrance requirements.
2. Complete the College Application and pay the College Admission Fee.
3. Declare a major in the Fire Science Technology A.S. degree and/or one of the fire related technical certificate programs.
4. Comply with the appropriate placement, course prerequisites and requirements of the college.
5. Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of required coursework in Valencia's Fire Science Technology A.S. degree and/or one of the fire related technical certificate programs before the transfer credit will be awarded on the official student transcript.
6. The Director of the Fire Rescue Institute at Valencia, will evaluate the student's record (certification), to determine the eligibility and notify the Registrar's Office of acceptable credit to be transferred and awarded.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

This agreement applies to students who have earned the Fire Investigator I Certificate of Competency from the Bureau of Fire Standards and Training. The agreement will be reviewed as needed and it shall remain in effect from July 2015 until there is a need for revision.
