ABOUT THIS LIMITED-ACCESS PROGRAM

The Leadership in Healthcare Program is designed for working professionals who have completed an A.S. degree in an approved Allied Health profession or Nursing at a regionally accredited institution. This program provides specialized course work for those aspiring to, or already in, leadership positions within their respective health professions. Students completing this certificate will gain knowledge and skills related to healthcare administrative and supervisory duties which will enable them to effectively perform leadership roles within healthcare.

This is a limited access, bachelor's-level program and admission to Valencia does not guarantee acceptance to the program. Program applicants must also submit a School of Allied Health Leadership in Healthcare Program Application and be accepted to the program. The program is online and some of the courses may require on-site testing at Valencia or at a location in your community. The program begins in fall, spring and summer terms. ***Although applications submitted prior to the priority application deadline are more likely to be processed for the upcoming term, applications can be submitted after the priority deadline.*** Students who meet all admission requirements are accepted to the program and become eligible to register for available courses being taught that term.

- _____ 5. Submit the documentation to request Florida Residency for tuition purposes.

Submit to Valencia's Admissions Office an official transcript that indicates you have earned an associate degree, or higher, in Cardiovascular Technology, Dental Hygiene, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Emergency Medical Services, Health Information Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology, Nursing, Radiation Therapy, Radiography, or Respiratory Care from a regionally accredited institution.

- _____ 7. Receive notification from Valencia Admissions Office of *admission as a candidate* for the Advanced Technical Certificate in Leadership in Healthcare.

After receiving notification of admission as a *candidate*, submit a School of Allied Health Leadership in Healthcare Program Application; the program application is available at <https://valenciacollege.edu/academics/programs/health-sciences/leadership-healthcare/> (No fee is required with the application.)

COST

All the courses are taught online, although some testing may be on campus; students outside Central Florida can make arrangements for testing in their community. BS in Radiologic and Imaging Sciences

Valencia also offers the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Radiologic and Imaging Sciences (BSRAD) with Concentrations in Leadership, CT, MRI, Mammography, Cardiac Ultrasound and Vascular Ultrasound. Students who are eligible to enroll in the B.S. in Radiologic and Imaging Sciences can apply the Leadership in Healthcare Advanced Technical Certificate toward degree graduation requirements. Eligible students are accepted to the BS degree every term--Fall, Spring and Summer. Valencia's Health Sciences programs are offered through the School of Allied Health and the School of Nursing, which provide information about specific admission criteria for the programs. The School of Allied Health program guides, of which this is one, are developed for a specific academic year (August to July) and, as a rule, changes to admission and program requirements become effective at the start of an academic year; however, **Valencia College reserves the right to make changes in admission and program requirements as circumstances require.** If a mid-year change becomes necessary, it will be indicated via valenciacollege.edu/west/health/admissionupdates.cfm.

You may apply to only one bachelor's-level Health Sciences program at a time and enrollment is limited to only one Health Sciences program in a term.

ATLAS EMAIL

MANDATORY ORIENTATION

There is not a program Orientation for the Advanced Technical Certificate in Leadership in Healthcare.

COURSE FORMAT

Leadership in Healthcare is an online program. Some of the courses may require on-site testing at a Valencia campus or at another proctored site if Valencia is not convenient for you. If you want to take your examinations in another proctored location, you will need to do so at an approved testing site such as a college or public library that offers proctoring services and which may require a fee.

BACKGROUND CHECK, FINGERPRINTING, DRUG TESTING, IMMUNIZATIONS AND CPR CERTIFICATION
