#### ABOUT THIS LIMITED-ACCESS PROGRAM

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program is designed for individuals who have completed an Associate of Nursing Degree from an accredited nursing program and are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX RN) or hold an active Florida RN license. The program provides an opportunity for nurses to further their education and increase their potential for career advancement. The curriculum offers advanced nursing research, leadership, nursing theories, and community health courses. Designed for working professionals, this is a self-paced online program (except for a 15-hour experiential learning component in the NUR 3634C – Community & Public Health Nursing and a 10-hour experiential learning component in NUR 4945C - Nursing Capstone courses) that can be completed as quickly as three terms or as slowly as one course per term.

#### PROGRAM CHECKLIST

1. Applicants must be one of the following: U.S. citizen, U.S. permanent resident, or non-immigrant visa (excluding F or J visa categories).
2. Review the RN to BSN program guide and program requirements in the <u>Valencia College Catalog</u> .
3. Submit a completed <u>Valencia College Admission Application</u> ( <u>valencia college.edu/apply</u> ). Application is free!
4. Submit final official transcripts from all previously attended colleges and universities, including one indicating the completion of an Associate Degree in Nursing from an accredited nursing program. Advising Note: High school transcripts may fulfill the foreign language requirement. Please refer to the graduation section for more details.
5. Hold a clear, active, unrestricted, unencumbered Florida RN license or be eligible to sit for the National Council Licensing Examination (NCLEX RN). Note: A copy of the RN license must be submitted before completing your first semester and before registering for NUR 3634C – Community & Public Health Nursing. This license will be collected after acceptance into the program.
6. Have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 or higher.
7. Receive notification from the Valencia Admissions Office of acceptance to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program.
8. Following program admission, complete the online Bachelor's New Student Orientation.
9. <u>Confer with the Bachelor's Nursing Student Success Coach</u> if assistance is needed relative to course selection, registration, and getting started in the program.

#### **Graduation Requirements**

In addition to completing the course requirements detailed in the curriculum to graduate, students must:

- Earn a minimum 2.0 Valencia College and Overall GPA.
- Complete all Core course work with a minimum grade of C (2.0) in all core courses.
- Satisfy Valencia's General Education requirements and Gordon Rule requirements unless you hold an Associate
  in Arts or Bachelor's degree or have completed the entire general education program at a regionally accredited
  institution.

- Satisfy the civic literacy requirement. As per Florida Rule 6A-10.04213, before the award of an associate in arts or baccalaureate degree, students initially entering a Florida College System institution in the 2021-22 school year\*, and after that must demonstrate competency in civic literacy before graduation by:
  - a. receiving a passing score on the Florida Civic Literacy Exam (FCLE), and
  - b. successful completion of one of the following:
    - successfully passing <u>POS 2041</u> U.S. GOVERNMENT, <u>AMH 2010</u> UNITED STATES HISTORY TO 1877 (only applies to Fall 2024 admits and forward), or <u>AMH 2020</u> U.S. HISTORY 1877 TO PRESENT or
    - successfully pass a prescribed assessment:
      - AP Government & Politics: United States Test\*\* (passing score =3), or
      - AP United States History Test\*\* (passing score = 4), or
      - CLEP American Government\*\* (passing score = 50)
      - \*The Department of Education has provided guidance that the Civic Literacy requirement is based on the student's governing catalog year (e.g., it is for all students who have a catalog year of Fall 2021 or after even if they had previously attended a Florida public institution).
      - \*\*receiving a passing score will satisfy both the FCLE and course requirements.
- Complete at least 25% of the 120-credit hour degree program (30 credits) at Valencia College, based upon the Florida College System's requirement of a 2+2 admission into the baccalaureate program. Fifteen of those hours must be 3000 or 4000 level courses from the program core course list.
- Apply for graduation through Atlas by the deadline listed in the Academic Calendar's official online catalog. To submit a graduation application, the student must have at least the minimum number of college-level credits for the degree, including all courses currently registered.
- Fulfill all financial obligations to Valencia College.
- Foreign Language: Complete the Florida foreign language requirement: two years of high school or one year of college (at least eight credits) in a single foreign language. American Sign Language is acceptable. Foreign language taken at the college level does not satisfy the General Education credits.
- Total Semester Credits required 120 credit hours in addition to completing the Foreign Language Requirement above. The credit courses required may vary depending on the student's credits to the BSN program. Additional courses to complete the required 120 credit hours for graduation must apply to the degree and be approved by an advisor.

#### Cost

The estimated total cost for the RN to BSN Completion Degree, including tuition for the 30 credits of program requirements, is approximately \$3,365.70 based on the price of \$112.19 X 30 credits. (This estimate does not include books, lab fees, or additional courses that you may be required to take to complete the BSN degree requirements)

#### **Registration Note:**

Once a student has been approved as "Course Registration Eligible," it is the student's responsibility to secure enrollment in the desired course(s).

#### **Atlas Email**

All communication from Valencia relative to program admission will be via your Atlas email. Written communication you send to Valencia staff should also be via your Atlas email and include your name and your Valencia ID number.

#### **Transfer Notes:**

- Students who hold an A.A. or bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution have satisfied Valencia's general education program requirements.
- Students transferring from a regionally accredited Florida public institution with the general education program (GEP) requirements met have satisfied Valencia's GEP requirements.
- 1000 and 2000 level courses do not substitute for upper-division 3000 4000 level courses.

## RN-BSN Sample Plan of Study

Courses will typically be taken in this order within 3-5 semesters. Each plan of study is individualized in consultation with an advisor.

#### **Advising Notes:**

General Education – Missing general education courses can be taken alongside core courses.

Florida Civic Literacy Requirement - Students admitted on or after Fall 2021 must meet the FCLE requirements. Plan on taking the exam no later than your second to last term.
