The Construction and Maintenance Accelerated Skills

Training program trains students to work in several specialized fields, learn from local companies about a wide range of topics from carpentry to residential maintenance, and earn industry-recognized certifications, which prepare them for high-demand, higher-wage careers.

Job Outlook in the Central Florida Area

Construction and maintenance jobs are on the rise in Central Florida and the demand for workers will continue for the foreseeable future. The future workforce needs are great (1.5 million workers) with great promotion potential. As the population continues to age and the need for construction and maintenance services continues to grow, so will the demand for a skilled workforce.

\$16-\$18 per hour

\$16-\$18 per hour
