

Baldwin 2425-213 **ARC 1701** Purpose: The Valencia College Architecture Department would like to increase the faculty contact hours to 4 credits due to moving forward to a Limited Access (Second Year) Program. We anticipate this change will require extra project and writing deliverables to prepare students for the application/portfolio process/submission; Revised Credit/Contact/Lab Hours: 3/4/0; Revised Course Description: This introductory course provides a general survey of cultural, aesthetic, and socio-political influences which have affected and shaped architecture from 10,000 BC (prehistoric times) through 1850. Additionally, students will develop the ability to think critically through the mastering of subjects concerned with human culture, especially architecture, and will include selections from the Western canon. Effective Date: Fall 2025 (202610).2425-214 **HUM 2250H** 20th and 21st Century Humanities-Honors, CCM......E. Wallman Purpose: Modify course description and outcomes; Revised Prerequisites: None; Revised Course Description: Integrated examination of dominant ideas in Western culture covering period from the turn of the twentieth century to the present. Focuses on creative forces which have shaped contemporary consciousness from pioneering work of Einstein, Picasso, Stravinsky and Wright through dominance of objective consciousness to newly emerging guiding myths of today. Affords students the ability to think critically through the mastering of subjects concerned with human culture, especially literature, history, art, music, and philosophy, and will include selections from the Western canon; Effective Date: Fall 2025 (202610).
