**2122-188 Nursing, Accelerated Track (Limited Access), CPM.....Ruby Alvarez**  
**Purpose:** Incorporate changes for HB 1507 and add math; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).

**2122-189 B.S. in Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology (A.S. Program Requirements), CPM.....Masood Ejaz**  
**Purpose:** Rearrangement of 21 hours of general education courses as a result of state-mandated changes to the A.S. ECET program; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).

**2122-190 A.S. in Energy Management and Controls Technology, CPM.....Deb Hall**  
**Purpose:** To prepare our EMCT graduates to sit for the Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA) exam which is widely recognized and encouraged within the Building Automation Systems (BAS) industry; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).

**2122-191 EGN 2210C Numerical Computations & Programming for Engineers, CCA.....Mohua Kar**  
**Purpose:** This course is equivalent to Valencia's COP 3275C and UCF's EGN 3211C. Electrical and Computer Engineering majors at UCF are required to take EGN 3211C (COP 3275C can be substitute for it) as their degree requirement. Therefore we would like to include it in our new AS- STEM degree program. As we cannot include a 3000 level course in Associate degree we would like to introduce this 2000 level equivalent course; **Credit/Contact/Lab:** 3/2/1;  
**Prerequisites:** Minimum grade of C in MAC 2312; **Co-requisites:** None; **Catalog Course Description:** This course provides a fundamental knowledge of computer operations and programming languages. Numerical computations in solving engineering problems will be emphasized. Students will use microcontroller for the class project. Minimum grade of C is required for the AS degree; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).



**2122-192      WOH 2012      World History to 1500, CCA.....Carl Creasman**  
**Purpose:** We believe that some students will find an interest in a survey-level history course that more formally incorporates examining South America, Africa and the Far Eastern world. This course will aligns UCF, so equally useful for transferability compared to the EUH series while also allowing more student choice regarding Gordon Rule (either EUH or WOH courses). Adding this course also puts us into alignment with most major colleges and universities beyond UCF, thus benefitting students who transfer to other institutions. Finally, we believe the WOH series is particularly relevant in an internationalized setting like Valencia and helps to prepare students to live and thrive in this time of globalization; **Credit/Contact/Lab:** 3/3/0; **Prerequisites:** Minimum grade of C in ENC 1101, ENC 1101H, or IDH 1110; **Co-requisites:** None; **Catalog Course Description:** Survey of the evolution of civilizations from ancient times to the modern era (1500 AD/CE) with emphasis on political, social, cultural, and economic development as they evolved in the various areas. Examines the ancient world and ancient civilizations, classical antiquity, the early nation-states in the various areas around the globe, world religions emergence and development, developments through the first millennium common era, the European Renaissance, intersection and connection between global regions including the early age of Exploration, and other topics that explore the interactions among various civilization regions. Gordon Rule course in which the student is required to demonstrate college-level writing skills through multiple writing assignments. Minimum grade C required if WOH 2012 is used to satisfy Gordon Rule requirements; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).



**2122-193      WOH 2022      World History Since 1500, CCA.....Carl Creasman**  
**Purpose:** We believe that some students will find an interest in a survey-level history course that more formally incorporates examining South America, Africa and the Far Eastern world. This course will aligns UCF, so equally useful for transferability compared to the EUH series while also allowing more student choice regarding Gordon Rule (either EUH or WOH courses). Adding this course also puts us into alignment with most major colleges and universities beyond UCF, thus benefitting students who transfer to other institutions. Finally, we believe the WOH series is particularly relevant in an internationalized setting like Valencia and helps to prepare students to live and thrive in this time of globalization; **Credit/Contact/Lab:** 3/3/0; **Prerequisites:** Minimum grade of C in ENC 1101, ENC 1101H, or IDH 1110; **Co-requisites:** None; **Catalog Course Description:** Survey of modern transformation of civilizations from 1500 to the present day with emphasis on political, social, cultural, and economic development as they evolved in the various areas. Examines the increasing interconnection of the various world regions emerging through the European Renaissance and age of exploration, the impact of the enlightenment and modern revolutions, the rise of modern nations throughout the world,

industrialism, imperialism, and the impact to the Indian, African, Far Eastern and American backgrounds and developments, the world wars, the Cold War, postcolonialism, and other topics that explore the interactions among various civilization regions. Gordon Rule course in which the student is required to demonstrate college-level writing skills through multiple writing assignments. Minimum grade C required if WOH 2022 is used to satisfy Gordon Rule requirements; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).

**2122-194      DIG 2109C      Digital Imaging Fundamentals, CCM.....Dominic DiPaolo**  
**Purpose:** Moving the DIG2132 pre-req from this course to DIG2341 Intro to motion graphics. This was preventing video production students from registering for this course without override approval; **Revised Prerequisites:** Minimum grade of C in DIG 2000C; and minimum grade of C in either TPA 1380 or SLS 1122; or departmental approval; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).

**2122-195      DIG 2341C      Intro to Motion Graphics, CCM.....Dominic DiPaolo**  
**Purpose:** Adding the pre-req of DIG2132 or ART1300. Previously this was attached to DIG2109, and this prevented video production students from registering for DIG2109. This fixes the registration issues, and moves the pre-req to a more relevant course; **Revised Prerequisites:** Minimum grade of C in DIG 2109C; and minimum grade of C in either DIG 2132C or ART 1300C; or department approval; **Effective Date:** Fall 2022 (202310).
