4. **Regular Agenda:**

**2324-260      EGN 2421      Engineering Analysis, CCA.....Mohua Kar**

**Purpose:** This course is equivalent to UCF's EGN 3420. EGN 3420 will be required by UCF for Electrical and Computer engineering majors from Fall 2024; **Credit/Contact/Lab Hours:** 3/3/0;

**Prerequisites:** Minimum grade of C in MAC 2312; **Corequisites:** None; **Course Description:**

Engineering applications of numerical methods using computer-aided analysis, including complex variables, curve fitting, matrix operations, Fourier series, and numerical integration;

**Effective Date:** Summer 2024 (202430).

*There was a question about if there would be any future legislative or state concerns about the equivalency of a 2000 and 3000 level courses since the state assigns different numbers to upper versus lower division courses. Will the course be transferable? The presenter stated that the courses will be.*

**2324-261      CIS 3000      Cybersecurity in Cloud Computing, CCA.....A. Evans**

**Purpose:** This course will be an elective for students in our cloud computing concentration. This will be the first cloud-specific elective for students in this pathway since they currently must choose from the software development courses to fulfill part of their electives;

**Credit/Contact/Lab Hours:** 3/3/0; **Prerequisites:** Minimum grades of C in CIS 3080 and CIS 3083C; **Corequisites:** None; **Course Description:** This course is intended to provide students with foundational and practical knowledge of cybersecurity principles for cloud computing. Topics include cloud security design principles, authentication protocols, network access infrastructure, data protection methodologies, logging and monitoring practices, and incident response. This course prepares the student for certification exams commonly offered in the cloud computing industry; **Effective Date:** Summer 2024 (202430).

*The first sentence of the course description was changed to: Provides students with foundational and practical knowledge of cybersecurity principles for cloud computing.*

*Proposal 2324-261 was approved tentatively pending a course number assignment from the SCNS.*

*The course number was approved as CIS 3644.*

**2324-268 SLS 1501H Honors Seminar, CCD**

**Purpose:** SCNS courses not taught in 5 years are required to be removed per section 1007.24 (9)(d), Florida Statutes; **Effective Date:** Fall 2024 (202510).

*Proposal 2324-262 was approved by consensus.*

**5. Information Items:**

- a) *Gen Ed package approved District Board of Trustees at May meeting. Reached out to SCNS and they gave us specific language to add to course descriptions/outcomes – particularly as it relates to Humanities Western Cannon. Will be making changes to course descriptions in July to satisfy the state requirements.*
- b) *New degree type approved by legislature this spring - Specialized transfer degree- will now be Specialized Associate in Arts Transfer degree- SAATS. SAATs will be effective Fall 2025 and will have more than 60 credits. They will be like our previous pre-majors in course structure with Common Program Prerequisites and required Core courses included. Financial aid will cover the courses above 60 credits as they are required for the new degree type. We have worked in conjunction with UCF and Direct Connect partners to build the first ones – Engineering, Computer Science, Biomedical/Biology, and Health Sciences.*

The next meeting of the College Curriculum Committee is scheduled for **July 10, 2024**, and will be a zoom meeting.
