

# STEPS TO ENROLL

International Student Admission Checklist for Valencia College Degree Programs

**APPLY** ▶  Complete international online application with a \$35 non-refundable fee ([valenciacollege.force.com/creditapply](https://valenciacollege.force.com/creditapply))

- SUBMIT** ▶ Submit admission documents at the time of the application or through the application portal
- Original secondary school transcripts and proof of graduation in English or with English translation
  - Send all college/university transcripts (if applicable)
    - Non-U.S. university transcripts should be submitted to a member of National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) such as World Education Services or Josef Silny ([wes.org](http://wes.org) or [jsilny.com](http://jsilny.com)) for a course-by-course evaluation
  - English proficiency (for non-native English speakers)
    - Results from the TOEFL IBT (minimum score 45), IELTS (minimum score 5.5) or LOEP exam (minimum score 86) or successful completion of at least 4 sessions at the Valencia College Intensive English Program (IEP) with a grade of "B" or better in level 6B or higher
  - Proof of financial support with supporting bank letter or statement in English or with English translation
  - Copy of passport
    - Students with dependents (spouse and/or children) will need to show additional funds and submit copies of each dependent passport
  - For current F-1 visa students in the U.S.
    - Copy of current F-1 visa and I-94 form
    - All current and previous I-20's
    - SEVIS Transfer Eligibility form
    - Students with dependents (spouse and/or children) will need to submit copies of F2 visa, I-20 and I-94 for each dependent

- RECEIVE** ▶  Receive admission letter and I-20 and instructions to set up Atlas student portal
- COMPLETE** ▶  Complete mandatory pre-arrival online international student orientation
- Make housing arrangements ([valenciacollege.edu/international-housing](https://valenciacollege.edu/international-housing))
  - Take placement exams (if applicable)
  - Pay for mandatory health insurance through myISS portal ([valenciacollege.edu/myISS](https://valenciacollege.edu/myISS))
  - Attend mandatory international student orientation
