After submitting your application, please allow up to five business days before attempting to sign up for a student portal (MyVC) account. By signing up for your student portal account you will also obtain your student portal email. Submit Submit proof of Florida residency to pay lower tuition.

If you have been a Florida resident for at least 12 months, you may be eligible for in-state tuition. All new and readmit students should submit their documents to claim Florida residency. For more information, visit valenciacollege.edu/residency

Complete Use Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and apply for scholarships. Learn more at valenciacollege.edu/finaid

You should apply for financial aid even if you think you don't qualify. There are many forms of support that you may be eligible for, which require you to complete and submit the FAFSA online. Allow at least six (6) weeks for your FAFSA to be processed.

Determine

Determine if you need to take a placement test.

When you first come to Valencia College, you may be required to take a placement test. If you haven't submitted your official <u>SAT</u>, <u>ACT</u> or high school Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT), taken within the last two years, we recommend taking the PERT so you can have access to as many classes as possible during your first term. Complete

☐ Complete Orientation and connect with a Student Success Coach.

Wait 24 hours after creating your student portal account and then log in. Search "New Student Orientation" in MyVC and click Sign Up.

In order to register for classes, degree-seeking students must complete New Student Orientation.

New Student Orientation is where you'll learn important information about the college, our degree programs, course registration (which courses to take and how to register) and tips on how you can be successful at Valencia College. You will need your Valencia College student portal username and password to log into the online orientation. After you complete the online orientation, you will be able to connect with a Student Success Coach and register for your first semester classes.

Register

Register for classes by searching "Register" in MyVC and clicking Register for Classes.

Review

Review your account balance and pay your tuition if necessary.

To pay, log in to MyVC and search "My Account Balance."

- If awarded financial aid, your aid will be applied directly to your account balance. You are responsible for any remaining balance.
- If you are using a Florida Prepaid College Plan and/or Bright Futures Scholarship, you may have a balance to pay as some fees are not covered by these programs.
