

The **A.S. in Fire Science Technology** degree program provides a career pathway to meet the needs of the fire service community. It is an open access degree program, which students can declare as a major as long as they meet all the college admission requirements. This program is financial aid eligible (FAFSA) for students who qualify. As part of your elective coursework, you can choose to take the three courses required to become EMT certified or take courses that are required to pursue other state of Florida fire-related certifications.

If you are a sworn firefighter in Florida or have fire related state licensures or certifications, you may be eligible for an Award of Credit. Students must meet the following criteria to receive college credits towards the degree:

- 1- Declare the A.S. in Fire Science Technology degree as a program of study
- 2- Meet the minimum residency requirement (complete 15 credits within the degree program at Valencia)
- 3- Provide the Career Program Advisor a valid copy of the approved license and/or certificate
