- Does not require government issued warning to be activated.

Coverage Considerations:

- Reimbursement of eligible expenses up to \$25,000 per occurrence, with no additional premium.
 - Limits can be increased to \$50,000 and \$100,000, respectively.
- Travel Guard, an AIG company and worldwide leader in travel insurance and assistance, must make all arrangements and authorize all expenses in advance of any benefits paid.
