

ACCUPLACER ESL LOEP Instructions

There are **4 computer parts** on this test:

Part #1- Type an essay (80 minute time limit)

-Verbs, nouns, basic phrases

Part #3- Reading (20 Questions- No time limit)

- Questions on reading material

Part #4- Language Use (20 Questions- No time limit)

- Sentence structure, subject-verb agreement

ACCUPLACER LOEP Rules

Read the following rules thoroughly. If there is something you don't understand, please ask for help. Once you have begun the test, you will be held responsible for following the rules.

- **Assessment staff may invalidate your scores if any of these testing rules are violated:**
 1. No dictionaries, calculators, watches, notes or any other aids are allowed during the test.
 2. Electronic devices such as cellphones, must be turned off (not on silent or vibrate).
 3. Food and drinks are not allowed in the testing room.
 4. You must remain on the testing website, do not open other windows, browsers, online calculators, or the start button.
 5. Scratch paper must be cut/shredded into small pieces at the end of testing.
- Cheating and/or engaging in misconduct are strictly prohibited and will result in a disciplinary meeting.
- The ACCUPLACER ESL LOEP test may be taken a maximum of 2 times per a 12-month period.
- In order to retake the ACCUPLACER ESL LOEP, students must:
 - Pay a retake fee of \$10.00
 - Wait at least 1 day after taking the ACCUPLACER ESL LOEP for the first time.
 - Not have begun EAP coursework.
