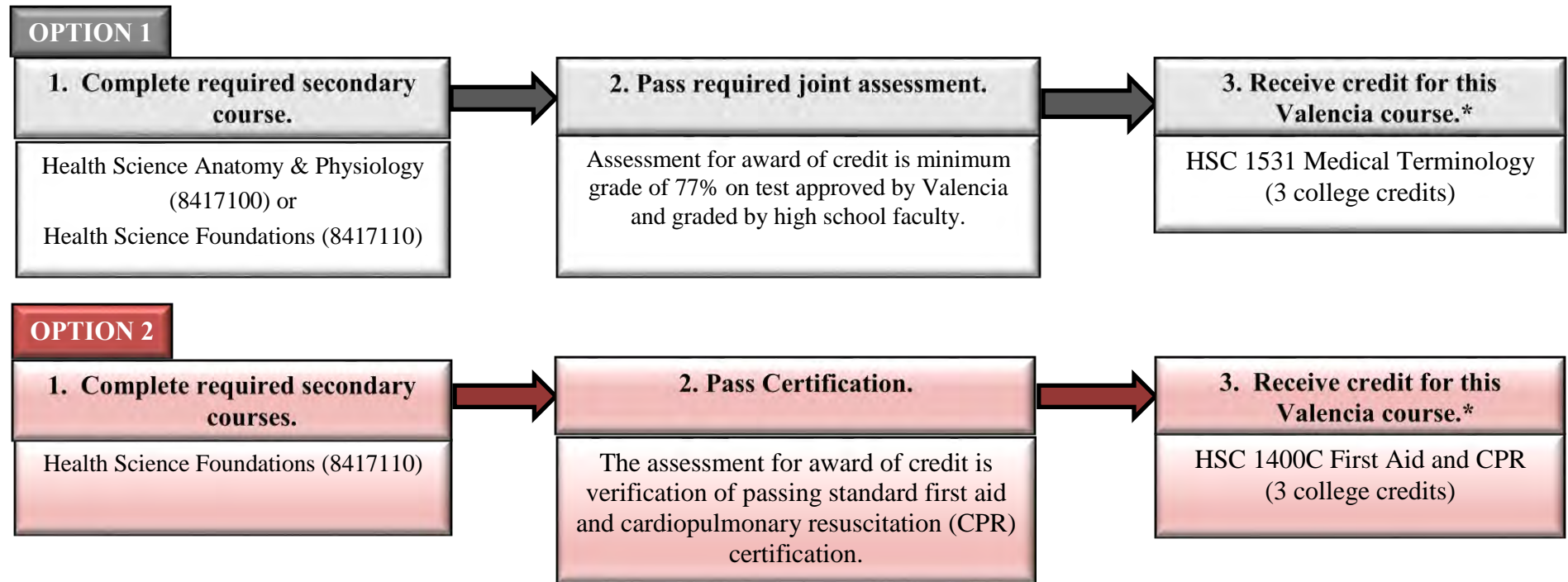


# Career Pathways Consortium Articulation Agreement

## Between Valencia Health Sciences Program\* and Orange/Osceola School Districts Health Science Programs

*High school students can earn Valencia College credits in the articulated Associate in Science degree program by meeting the following requirements:* 1. Complete required secondary Health Science courses with grade “C “or better. 2. Prior to high school graduation, pass joint assessment with a minimum score of 77% and/or passing score on the CPR certification. 3. *Enroll and attend Valencia College after high school graduation.* Valencia College will award Career Pathways credits up to 24 months after high school graduation. Students wishing to transfer these Career Pathways credits to another college or university should first check with that institution. **Please note: The following courses can only be applied to the Health Information Technology, Radiography, and Diagnostic Medical Sonography A.S. degree programs at Valencia College.**

*\*Most of the Health Science programs are limited access. Please check the catalog for admissions requirements.*



Career Pathways credits will give students 3 or more elective points for the admissions selection process in allied health programs. Note: Students must graduate from high school and have their Career Pathways credits posted on their Valencia transcript to use these elective points on their program specific admission application.
