## SAGE Redesigns the Valencia Global Distinction Program

In summer 2020, the SAGE Office initiated the framework of a collaborative process to restructure the existing Valencia Global Distinction program. The program was redesigned to create a more accessible learning pathway for students by identifying program outcomes, adding virtual co-curricular options, refreshing the VGD Canvas course, creating more opportunities for students to engage with faculty/staff, and adding a new learning pathway for completion (Global Ambassador). SAGE worked collaboratively with faculty and staff, as well as partnered with different programs, offices, departments, and clubs around the college (e.g., PJI, VISA Club, MAP Club, Seneff Honors College) to bring students engaging, global co-curricular experiences.
