Purpose: Proposed changes are meant to clarify the nature of FLDOE's mandatory requirement of "15 hours of field experience in a school setting" for both students considering registering for the course and faculty teaching the course. We hope this reduces the number of students who are unaware of the state's field experience requirement for this course; Revised Course Description: General overview of teaching developed through study of processes of teaching and learning, organization and structure of American education and current issues and problems related to education. This course also requires a minimum of 15 hours of field experience in an elementary, middle, or high school setting. This course is generally required as a prerequisite for state university teacher education programs in Florida. Tullis *Purpose:* This course will allow honors students to attempt CRW 2001 while also receiving honors credit; *Credit/Contact/Lab Hours:* 3/3/0; *Prerequisites:* ENC 1101 or ENC 1101H or IDH 1110; *Corequisites:* None; *Course Description:* An interactive writing course in which students develop creative writing skills in selected literary genres--short stories, poetry, plays, novels, personal essays or magazine articles--with additional honors content and outcomes; *Effective Date:* Summer 2024 (202430).

2324-251 NUR 2804C Professional Nursing and Health Concepts II, CCAR. Alvarez Purpose: Curriculum was changed to allow only one pathway but added an extra semester to increase student success. The course was previously approved under a different course number. Need new course number to circumvent confusion for students registering under old curriculum pathway; Credit/Contact/Lab Hours: 6/14/4; Prerequisites: Admission to Nursing A.S. Degree, minimum grades of C in BSC 2094C, NUR 1020C, NUR 1061C, NUR 2522C, NUR 1141C, NUR 2221C, NUR 1407C, NUR 2223C; Corequisites: None; Course Description: This course focuses or the concepts of healthcare organizations, technology & informatics, health care law, healthcare quality, safety, professional identity, and clinical judgement. Emphasis is placed on leadership roles, management of care, coordination of care services, and collaboration with the healthcare team members to ensure safe and effective care for patients, families and significant others in the care environment. This course will relate nursing accountability to legal, ethical, and regulatory frameworks. This course will also emphasize the knowledge, skills, and attitude that transition from a student nurse's role to an entry-level registered nurse's role. Learning experiences will be conducted in a variety of patient care settings. Upon completion, the student will meet the end of program learning outcomes. A grade of satisfactory in the clinical/lab is required; Effective Date: Summer 2024 (202430).
2324-252 NUR 4296 Emergency Preparedness and Disaster Nursing, CCAR. Alvare: Purpose: The request is made to align the course ID with the RN to BSN nursing program nomenclature; Credit/Contact/Lab Hours: 3/3/0; Prerequisites: Admission to the BSN program; NUR 3825; Corequisites: NUR 3825; Course Description: This course uses a competency-based conceptual framework to provide online RN to BSN students the opportunity to explore the various facets of natural and technological disasters while integrating public health research designs and practices. Discussions will utilize recent and historical case studies as the basis for developing the critical thinking and leadership skills needed by healthcare professionals in crisis situations. International, domestic, and regional settings will be addressed, as well as the social,
economic, and political aspects of disaster planning, preparedness, and mitigation. Students also gain an understanding of basic public health concepts and methodologies. Healthy People/WHO indicators will be used in evidence-based decision-making, and public health tools such as epidemiology and biostatistics will be reinforced during the process of community assessment; Effective Date: Summer 2024 (202430).
