WHAT IS UDOIT?

UDOIT is a tool embedded inside Canvas courses that supports faculty as they develop, redesign, and deliver quality accessible online courses. UDOIT scans courses to ensure accessibility to support Universal Design for Learning (UDL) teaching and learning practices.

WHY SHOULD I USE THIS?

UDL teaching gives all students an opportunity to learn, and UDOIT helps professors see their courses through a Universal Design lens, identifying areas for improvement that are not always intuitive when building a course. UDOIT also helps professors align their courses with criteria in Section 2 of the Rubric for Online Competencies.

STUDENT BENEFITS

Text styles help learners using only a keyboard to navigate sections on a page.

Color contrast assures that all learners who view the course will be able to see the content.

Alt-text helps learners with screen readers to get information about images.

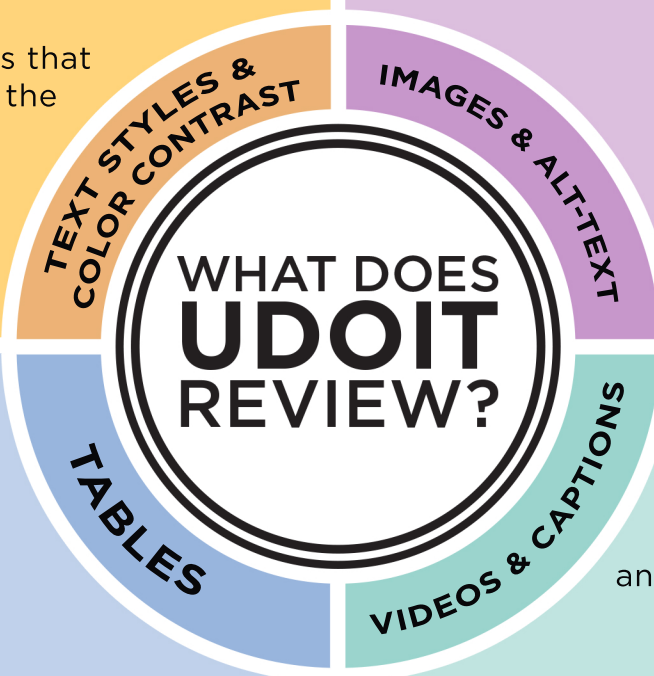
