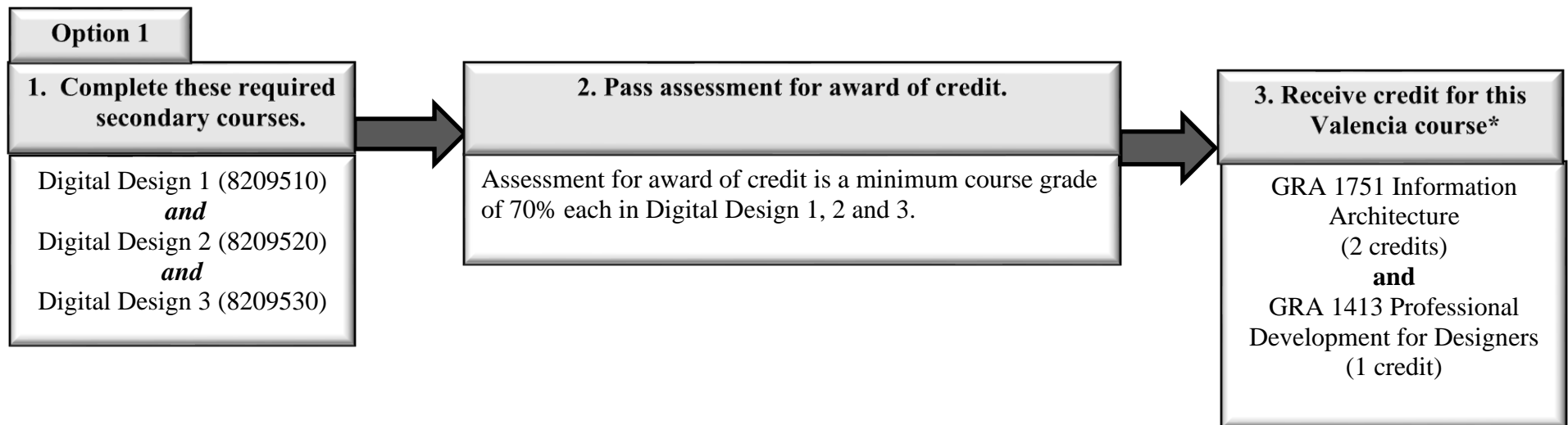


Career Pathways Consortium Articulation Agreement

Valencia Graphic and Interactive Design Program and Orange/Osceola School Districts Digital Design Program

High school students can earn Valencia College credits in the articulated Associate in Science degree program by meeting the following requirements: 1. Complete each required secondary Digital Design course with “C” or better. 2. Prior to high school graduation, students must pass Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign certifications or end of course exam *and* graphics portfolio, and earn one Expert level certification in Photoshop, Illustrator or InDesign. 3. *Enroll and attend Valencia College after high school graduation.* Valencia College will award Career Pathways credits up to 24 months after high school graduation. Students wishing to transfer these Career Pathways credits to another college or university should first check with that institution. **Please note: The following courses can only be applied to Graphic and Interactive Design A.S. degree program at Valencia College.**



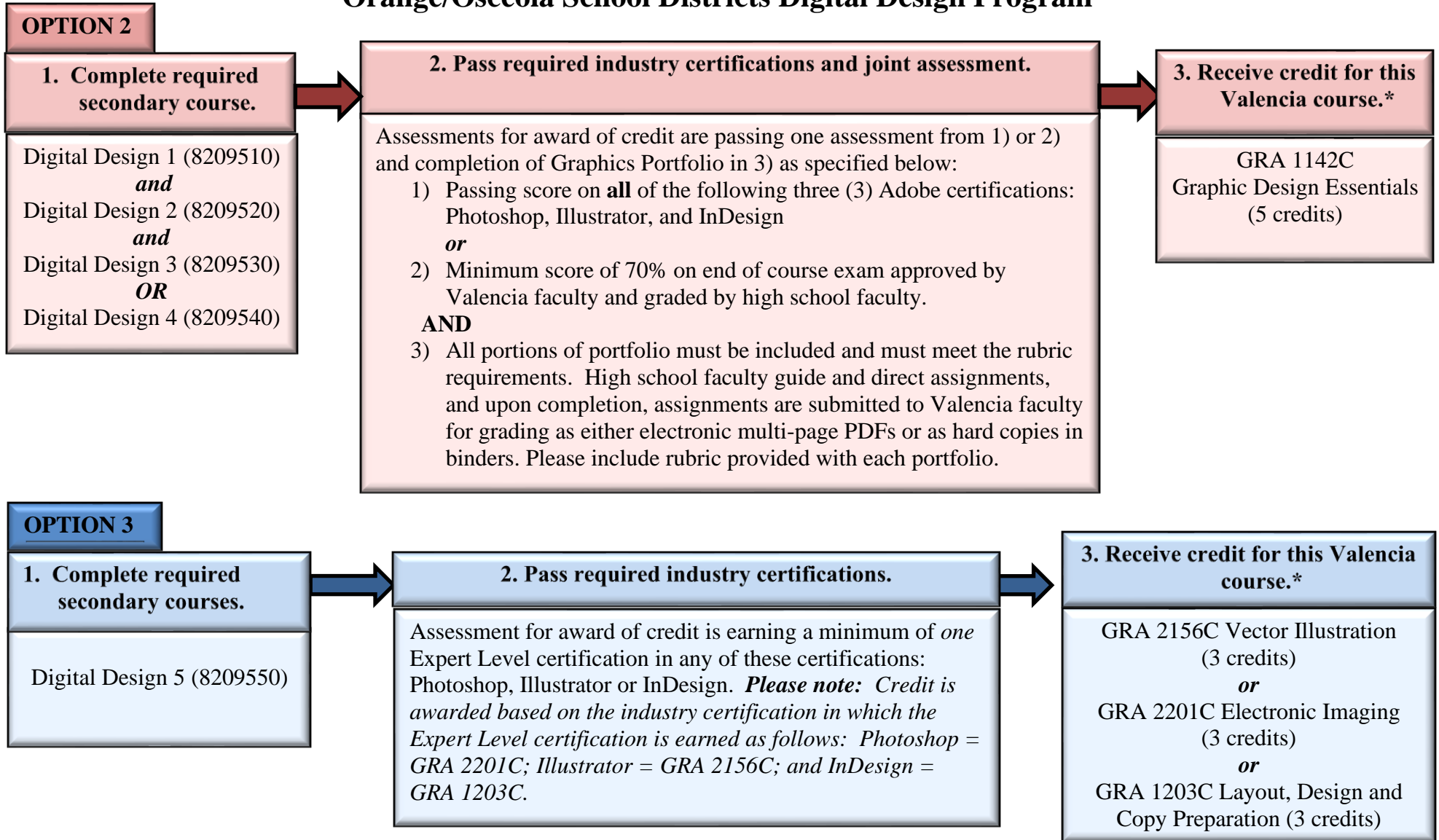
